“Trout/Salmon in the Class Room” - Approval Procedure

The Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department provides trout eggs, and in special circumstances landlocked Atlantic salmon eggs to qualified educational facilities throughout Vermont. The following procedure details how to acquire eggs and stock fry in appropriate Vermont waters.

To obtain authorization to receive eggs from the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department or the United States Fish & Wildlife Service’s Fish Culture Stations, please complete the attached application and return it to the contact provided below by November 15 of the calendar year in which you would like to receive eggs.

Completed applications will be reviewed, and upon approval, the applicant will receive an authorization letter from the Commissioner of the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department. The letter will include additional information about acquiring and distributing the hatched fry.
