 - Sheppard Colchester. Propose taking of 46 individuals of Houghton's flatsedge (*Cyperus* houghtonii) to facilitate construction of a 28-unit housing development. This was discussed at the Jan 2022 meeting prior to getting input from Flora Advisory Group.
 - Merrick Mt Horrid, Rochester. Amateur plant breeder proposes to collect seeds from roseroot (Sedum rosea) to germinate and grow them to determine whether they can be grown commercially as a medicinal source. This application warrants further discussion.
