### Barton River Streambank Management Area

#### **General Description**

The Barton, Black, and Clyde rivers, along with their tributaries, make up the bulk of the Lake Memphremagog watershed and offer excellent coldwater fishing opportunities in northeastern Vermont. Barton River SMA contains a productive fishery of Brook, Brown, and Rainbow Trout, as well as White Sucker. Downstream, north of I-91, there tend to be more large Rainbow and Brown Trout but fewer Brook Trout. The upper portion of the river holds an abundance of all three species, though they are generally smaller. Steelhead migrate through the entire watershed during the spring to spawn, but perhaps the best place to watch and fish for them is at Willoughby Falls in Orleans. In the far downstream sections of the river, Willoughby Falls and South Bay WMA provide additional access to the Barton River.
