### Willoughby River Streambank Management Area

#### **General Description**

The Willoughby River is the largest tributary of the Barton River, which flows into Lake Memphremagog in Coventry, VT. Originating from Lake Willoughby in Westmore, the Willoughby River travels nine miles until its confluence with the Barton River, joining with its main tributaries – the Brownington Branch and Lords Brook – along the way. Willoughby River SMA provides access to the Willoughby River's productive coldwater fishery, with Rainbow and Brown Trout present throughout, and Brook Trout available primarily in Lords Brook. Willoughby Falls in Barton is a premier destination to witness Steelhead, the migratory form of Rainbow Trout, leap over the cascades as they travel upstream.


