SUMMARY OF 2005 PUBLIC ACCESS MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

REPORT

The Vermont Department of Fish and Wildlife maintains over 180 developed access areas. These sites provide public access to waters in Vermont for shore fishing and launching of water craft. Thirteen of the F & W access areas are equipped with universal shore fishing platforms that provide access for anglers with disabilities and anglers of all ages. One more fishing platform was constructed this summer at Kent Pond in Killington. The Department has also assisted in the construction of three other sites.

The development and maintenance costs for access areas range from several hundred to several hundred thousand dollars. Projects of considerable size are formally advertised for bid. Projects of lesser size, involving minor maintenance, are completed by equipment rental through various local contractors. Eleven Community Restitution Crews provided by the Vermont Department of Corrections complete access area routine maintenance. In remote locations, where the number or concentration of access areas is not cost effective to have a Community Restitution Crew, local contractors are hired.

Popular access areas are provided with portalets and waste management contractors provide bids for areas they are interested in servicing. The contractors are responsible for providing and maintaining portalets for sites they are awarded. During the winter months, only access areas providing ice fishing opportunities retain a portalet. Vermont has many secluded access areas. Portalets at these areas are often vandalized. As a result, the majority of the portalets have been secured to concrete pads and protected with large boulders. Access areas where vandalism continues to be a problem and facilities are necessary are equipped with manufactured steel portalets. Five steel portalets, each costing over \$1,000 have been constructed and installed. The approximate cost to maintain a portalet is \$20 per week.

The department continues to take part in joint venture projects with municipalities that allow for access areas to be constructed or upgraded. The newest access that was constructed during the summer of 2005 is at Chipman's Point in Orwell. Fish and Wildlife purchased land from the adjacent marina and constructed a parking area. An agreement was signed with the Town of Orwell to construct a reinforced concrete boat ramp on land they own. The public benefits from these projects because towns receive improved launching and fishing facilities and in most cases the department does not increase their annual maintenance cost. We are presently considering two additional access projects in Newport and South Hero.

As in previous years, the adopt-a-dock program continues. Unfortunately not all the groups have continued with the installation and maintenance of docks that has resulted in increased maintenance cost to the department. Two new docks are proposed at Lake St. Catherine and Benson Landing. The annual cost to maintain these docks at access areas statewide typically runs between \$ 12,000 and \$ 15,000 annually.

In 2005, the Department added a page on the Vermont Fish and Wildlife Web Site that includes information on Vermont Public Access Areas. Users may now search and gain information about access areas including location, parking, ramp type, as well as the fish species one might expect to encounter in the water body where the access is located. Further improvements to this web page are forthcoming as public interest about Fishing and Boating Access Areas appears to be on the increase.

The department is looking forward to 2006 and the completion of more non-motorized access improvement projects made possible by House Bill H.832. The department continues to work with municipalities, river commissions, and interested groups to add to the list of present and potential sites.
