

2018 Moose Capture Update: Nulhegan Basin

Overview:

During the 2018 capture season we collared a total of 36 moose between the dates of January 13 and January 15. All animals were captured within our study area which encompasses Wildlife Management Units (WMU) E1 and E2. Of the 36 marked individuals 6 are adult cows and 30 are calves with a calf sex ratio of 21 males to 9 females. Other notable points include an average calf weight of 385 pounds (n= 29) and an average tick count of 33 ticks per moose (up from an average of 23 last year). I have attached a map of all capture locations from this year to give a feeling for the distribution of our collars. The numbers associated with each pin are animal ID's.
