STATUTORY AUTHORITY: 10 V.S.A. SECTION 4142

### Clyde River, Newport to Charleston

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 V.S.A. §4142, the section of Clyde River (located in the towns of Charleston, Derby, Holland, Morgan and Newport City within Orleans County) beginning at the top of the abandoned mill dam located immediately upstream of the Newport 1, 2, 3 hydroelectric powerhouse and extending upstream to the top of the West Charleston Dam which impounds West Charleston Pond (Lubber Lake) including Little Salem Lake, Big Salem Lake, Clyde Pond and tributary streams is hereby designated as Test Waters from **October 1, 2014 to December 31, 2018**.

During the above specified period, from October 1 through October 31 of each year - all dates inclusive, fishing shall be in accordance with the following:

A. Minimum lengths, daily limits, and possession limits are as follows:

All landlocked Atlantic salmon caught must be released immediately.

B. Gear restrictions are as follows:

Fishing is restricted to use of artificial flies and lures in the Clyde River mainstem. This gear restriction does not apply to lakes, ponds and side tributaries.
