Private ponds may be stocked without a permit provided they are stocked with brook trout, brown trout, or rainbow trout, and in numbers not exceeding 4,000 fish per pond per year. The fish must be obtained solely from the sources listed above.

If you are thinking of purchasing fish species to release into public waters, **no fish may be stocked** into public waters without a permit issued by the Vermont Fish & Wildlife Department (VTFWD). [Learn more at Stocking Fish into Public or Private Waters Rules & Requirements](#)
