1. Can you leave a baited line unattended while you go to the store for a snack? **NO.**

2. Is it legal to use a 1/8 oz. split-shot lead sinker while fishing? **NO.**
Page 35 – see “Lead Sinkers” under General Requirements & Prohibitions.
Page 43- see “Toxic Behavior”
3. Is it legal to move largemouth bass from one pond to another? **NO, unless you have a permit.**
Page 34 – see “Possession of Live Fish” under General Requirements & Prohibitions.
Page 33 – see “Fish stocking”
4. What is foul hooking? **Hooking a fish in any part of the body, other than the mouth.**
Page 31 – see “Foul Hooking” under General Requirements and Prohibitions.
5. At what age does a person need a license to fish? **15.**
Page 16 – see “Exceptions to License Requirements”.
6. How many rainbow trout can you take per day from Nelson Pond? **2 -- if you don't have any other trout or salmon and if they are in season.**
Page 81 – see Index of Lakes & Ponds”.
7. How many 16” trout can you keep in stream section #102 of the Winooski River? **None. 10”- 16” protected slot and must be released.**

8. Can you wear felt-soled waders in Vermont waters? **Yes. The ban on felt soled waders has been repealed effective July 1, 2016**

9. When do ice-fishing shanties have to be removed from the ice? **Before the last Sunday in March or before the ice becomes unsafe, whichever comes first.**
