

# Deer Tooth Removal Process



**IMPORTANT! You must provide the whole tooth, including the root. Age can only be determined from the root.**

With a knife, cut deeply down through the gums on both sides of one of the middle incisors.

Using the back of your knife, or pliers, gently pry forward until the entire tooth, including the root, comes free.



Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife

Once you have removed the tooth, place the incisor in the F&W paper envelope provided by the reporting station.

It is OK if there is gum tissue attached to the tooth.

Completely fill in the tooth envelope, including your Conservation ID.
