Dear License Applicant:

The Commissioner may issue to a Vermont resident who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States, upon application and receipt of satisfactory proof that the applicant is, or ever has been, sixty percent (60%) disabled as result of a service-connected disability, a free permanent fishing license, or if the applicant qualifies for a hunting license, a free permanent combination hunting and fishing license. A resident of a state which provides a reciprocal privilege for Vermont veterans and who qualify for a free license, if the person were a Vermont resident, may receive a free one-year fishing license or if the applicant qualifies for a hunting license, a free one-year fishing license.

To receive your license, please remit the following:

- Notification or an awards letter issued by the Veteran's Administration specifically stating that you are 60%, or more, disabled as a result of service-connected disability.
- The VT Sporting License Application form (attached) completed and signed by the applicant.
- Proof of a previous hunting license or hunter safety card, if you are requesting a hunting and fishing combination license. If you have had a hunting license previously but are unable to locate a copy, you may complete a license affidavit form (attached) and send it in place of a copy of your old license.

If you are a non-resident, in addition to the above documents, you must also provide a statement on letterhead from the Fish and Wildlife Department of the State in which you are a resident, stating that they provide a reciprocal privilege for Vermont residents.
