STATEMENT OF DISABILITY

The permit to hunt from a motor vehicle, off the right of way may be issued to a licensed hunter who is a paraplegic or is certified by a physician to be unable to pursue game because of a **PERMANENT severe physical disability**. If the applicant's disability is not a **PERMANENT** disability, or if you are unsure that the disability is permanent, or if the applicant can walk 25 feet (25 feet is generally the required distance from a public highway to shoot at wildlife) please do not fill out this application. **These permits are issued to permanently disabled persons ONLY**. Please note that we reserve the right to call and verify the disability.
